### Marilyn Perry Leadership Award

This award is given annually to a Junior clubwoman who demonstrates outstanding leadership qualities and abilities and used them to benefit both her GFWC club and her community. She is an active leader in community organizations and/or projects (e.g. church, charities, schools, government) while maintaining positions of leadership within GFWC or within her GFWC club.

Please note: the Marilyn Perry Leadership Award focuses on clubwomen who take the leadership skills they learned thru GFWC and use those skills in the community at large. It is an award recognizing leadership in general – not just within a club or GFWC.

Nomination for the Marilyn Perry Leadership Award is a special honor for a clubwoman. All club nominees will be recognized at the GFWC MA Combined Convention in 2022.

Each club is allowed one entry. Former state winners of this award are not eligible for nomination.



Entries must be typed, double spaced, and no more than two pages.



Each entry must have a cover page that includes your club name and your club president's name. If you would like confirmation of receipt of your entry, please indicate on the cover sheet "Confirm receipt" along with your email address.
