



Junior Director Themes and Symbols

Founder and first president of GFWC of Massachusetts Julia Ward Howe set a precedent of choosing a theme for her administration and Directors of Junior Clubs continued the practice of identifying their administration with a theme and symbol. Prior to 1956 the head of Junior Membership had been known as Chairman, or President; in 1954 the position became known as the Director of Junior Clubs, and an Executive Board of Junior Membership was formed. Previous to 1964 Junior Director reports were not included in the state Manual, so little information is known about themes of earlier Directors.
